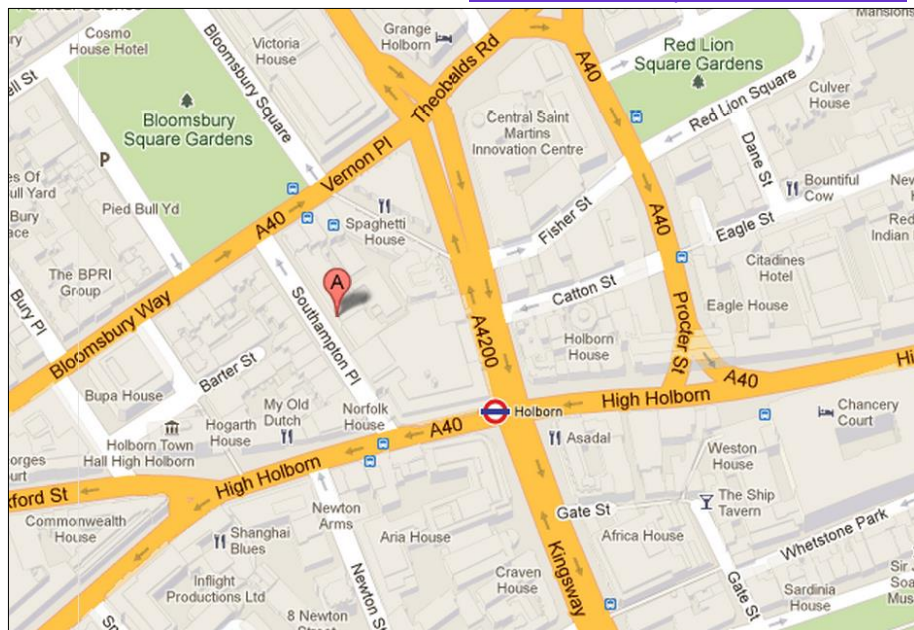

Dear Student

Welcome to Bloomsbury International! We are delighted that you have chosen to study with us and we hope that you have a wonderful time.

It is very important to us that you enjoy your programme, and it is also extremely important that you feel safe and comfortable here.

Here are a few rules that all our students must follow (please let us know if there is anything you don't understand and we will be very happy to help you).

Rules - at all times:

- Your guardian must always know where you are.
- Make sure that you have this document at all times because it contains very important information, including school telephone numbers.
- Follow your guardian's instructions at all times.
- Always tell your guardian if you have any problems, if you are feeling unwell or if you need help with anything.

School rules:

- Always arrive in time for your lesson and make sure you wear your student card.
- Speak in English at all times.
- Never leave the school without telling your guardian.
- Look after your belongings (e.g. bag, money, mobile phone) at all times. Bloomsbury International cannot look after your belongings for you at any time.
- Eating and drinking are not allowed in any classrooms or computer rooms. You can, however, have a bottle of water with you.
- Your teachers will prepare fun and useful lessons for your class – try and enjoy them as much as possible.
- Do not use your mobile phone during your lessons.
- Please respect all other students and staff – be kind, be polite, be friendly and do not make too much noise in the corridors.
- Please leave the bathroom tidy and the toilet seat clean
 - do not put your feet on the toilet seat
 - always put toilet paper in the toilet and other things in the bins provided
 - never put food down the toilet or in the sinks
 - Use the sink to wash your hands thoroughly but please do not use it to wash your hair, feet, or anything else.
- It is against the law to smoke on the school premises.

Homestay rules:

- Your host family is happy to have you and we hope you enjoy your stay with them.
- Please follow the **house rules** from your host family. If you do not understand them, please ask your host, guardian or school staff to help you.
- Give your host a copy of your *social programme* so that they know your plans at all times. Always tell them if you're going to be late home for dinner.
- Do you know what time you have breakfast and dinner? Your host can tell you because they will make your **meals**. Please do not use their **kitchen** to cook, you are not allowed.
- You are not allowed to use your host's **telephone**. Please ask them if there is an emergency.
- Many families have **internet** connection and some have Wi-Fi – please ask them if you would like to use it. You need their permission every time.
- Please keep the **bathroom** tidy and the toilet seat clean
 - do not put your feet on the toilet seat
 - always put toilet paper in the toilet and everything else in the bins provided
 - never put food down the toilet or in the sinks
 - use the sink to wash your hands thoroughly but please do not use it to wash your hair, feet, or anything else
 - Ask your host what time would be the best for you to have a shower or a bath every day. Try not to spend too long in the bathroom as others might be waiting to use it.
- Keep your **bedroom** tidy and do not keep any food there. If you have some food, ask your host family where you can keep it.
- Smoking is not allowed in the house.
- If you go out:
 - You must always tell your host family and guardian where you're going and what time you'll be back.
 - If you are **16 or 17 years old** you must return home every evening by **10pm** at the latest
 - If you are **younger than 16 years old**, you must return home every evening by 9pm at the latest.
